Cost of Rain Barrels: Price of barrels is \$60 (\$50 for Gunpowder Valley Conservancy members) but you may be eligible for a 50% cost share and free installation assistance through our Clear Creeks Project if you live in the Middle River, Tidal Gunpowder, or Bird River watersheds. Eligibility is determined at registration. Cost includes rain barrel, assembly kit, and decoration materials.
