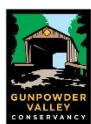

**Where:** Maryland State Game & Fish Protective Association, 8735 Honeygo Blvd, Perry Hall 21128. Look for the small MSGFPA sign at the entry road. It is adjacent to Joppa View Elementary School on Honeygo Blvd. Follow the dirt entry road to parking lot. A planting crew chief will instruct you from there.

**Equipment:** Wear **long sleeves and pants, boots, hat, gloves,** and bring **water bottle, rain gear, and tick repellent.** Refreshments will be provided.
