- The water you save can be used for garden and lawn watering, washing your boat, car or tools.

**Cost for Barrel:** Residents who live in our Clear Creeks Project area (the Bird River, Middle River, Tidal Gunpowder, or Lower Gunpowder Falls watersheds) and purchase a barrel will receive a 50% discount. The discount price is \$30 each barrel through the Clear Creeks Project Cost/Share Program. And GVC is happy to install your rain barrel free of labor and for cost of installation part only (\$10).

For all others, if you are a Gunpowder Valley Conservancy member the cost is \$50, non-members is \$60, (cost includes rain barrel and assembly kit).

*Rain Barrels are a way to implement Baltimore County's Small Watershed Action Plan (SWAP). Its goal is to reduce nutrient, sediment and pollution run-off that enter our local waters and ultimately the Chesapeake Bay.*
