EXPLORE THE Signature **GUNPOWDER**

Tuesday, April 22, 2025 - Tuesday, June 3, 2025 Location: Hybrid, at your own pace

The Explore the Gunpowder Watershed Challenge is a 6 week long event where participants are encouraged to connect with nature, local businesses, and environmental stewardship. Your business will be featured throughout the event period and through a variety of print and online materials with a reach of about 8,000.

Participants complete challenges at their own pace and can also join in scheduled activities at venues around the watershed.



Activity Challenge: Complete 45 miles of activity symbol of the length of the Gunpowder Watershed



Exploration Challenge: Visit local nature centers and businesses to earn stickers in our Gunpowder Passport. You can also earn a sticker for attending a GVC workshop or volunteer activity

This inclusive event is at your own pace — participants can bike, walk, run, roll, swim, or otherwise move throughout the watershed. In previous years, our Explore participants logged over 760 miles. We expect to have at least 100 participants in 2025.

The Gunpowder Passport makes this a perfect event for local businesses who would like to engage with the community in a fun way. Our participants are competitive and want to collect as many stamps as possible during their travels.




ANNUAL FUNDRAISER
