Our Collaboration Beer is Here!





GVC Stands with Land Trusts in Opposition to MPRP



GVC has signed a joint letter with 21 land trusts and conservation organizations to voice our opposition to MPRP powerline locations on permanently preserved lands. Allowing transmission lines to travel through preserved properties violates the requirements of the IRS, the purpose of our non-profits, and most importantly the trust that landowners have placed in land trusts to protect their land in perpetuity. Doing so is inherently detrimental to the scenic, natural, recreational, productive, and open space attributes of the properties that land trusts are obligated to protect.
