While stormwater management doesn't sound very soothing, our work with the <u>Chesapeake Mental Health Collaborative</u> (CMHC) is a great example of the therapeutic potential of incorporating conservation gardens in a built-up environment. GVC has been working with CMHC to prepare a master plan for their property in Towson that would feature green infrastructure to address stormwater runofff. The design would also create green space to accommodate the clinical practice of Nature Informed Therapy.

Heidi Schreiber-Pan, CMHC Founder and Executive Director, recently reflected on the value of partnering with GVC:

"Although we're in the planning stages, our shared vision is already blossoming--exploring ways to transform stormwater management into an opportunity for growth, and envisioning a green space that not only heals the environment but also becomes a sanctuary for mental health and wellness.

This project isn't just about creating a space; it's about engaging our community in meaningful ways, connecting them with nature and one another, and inspiring a deeper appreciation for the interconnectedness of mental, emotional, and environmental health."
