

## **Early Bird Ends This Week**





Maryland Piedmont Reliability

Project



We want to ensure that our watershed supporters are aware of the Maryland Piedmont Reliability Project that was awarded to NJ-based Public Service Enterprise Group (PSEG). The project includes an approximately 70-mile proposed transmission route from northern Baltimore County to southern Frederick County. Gunpowder Valley Conservancy representatives attended the July 9th public information session to learn about the project. We have also been working with growing coalitions to amplify our voice.

For decades, community leaders, farmers, and environmentalists have worked to preserve land throughout our region. Preserved land provides many benefits ranging from producing nutritious food for our community to protecting our water and air quality. The Gunpowder Valley Conservancy strongly opposes the destruction of preserved lands for any purpose. To do so undermines the substantial financial investment by private landowners, state agencies, and land trusts to protect the natural, agricultural, and historic features preserved in conservation easements.

What can you do as a concerned citizen? Speak your mind! The Maryland Public Service Commission has established an email address for submitting public comment: <a href="mailto:piedmontcomments.psc@maryland.gov">piedmontcomments.psc@maryland.gov</a>. At present time, PSEG has not filed a project application with the Maryland Public Service Commission. However, if the company does open a case, the comments submitted to the above address will be added to the public comments file.
