


Honoring Your Hard Work

GVC was one of two nonprofits <u>selected by Resource Environmental</u> <u>Solutions (RES) as 2024 EcoGuardians</u> for the Mid-Atlantic Region! Inspired by their employees' passion for environmental causes, RES created these awards to support nonprofits that are doing great work for the Earth. The recognition comes with a generous \$2,500 contribution to support GVC's efforts. Special thanks to GVC stream captain, Will Weaver, for the nomination! Will and his wife organize stream clean-ups of Long Quarter Branch each year.



In the 1990's, the GVC motto was "because the commitment begins at home." This sense of personal responsibility to protect and preserve the Gunpowder Watershed still drives many of our volunteers to go above and beyond. Last year, GVC initiated a partnership with Hampton National Historic Site (NHS) to help re-establish the forest buffer around the park where several hundred trees were lost to the emerald ash borer and other damage.
