We are pleased to announce that **Ebram Victoria**, an experienced stormwater landscape designer-builder, has been hired as our new Clear Creeks Landscape Assessor. In this role, Ebram will be responsible for evaluating perspective client properties to determine the suitability for our many conservation programs. Each property will be provided a free report, outlining recommended programs and restoration practices. If you are interested in having your property assessed for rain gardens, micro-bioretention practices, Bayscapes, and/or trees, please fill out our Clear Creeks pre-assessment form.

Please note that the ENTIRE Gunpowder Watershed is now eligible to receive our *Clear Creeks* discounts; this will be updated on our website by early 2025. If you filled out a form earlier this year, you already are on the wait list for a free property assessment. We thank you for your patience as we grow our programs!
